CERSA Call for Applications for Post-Doctoral positions

Nowadays, it is well known that most of African people are suffering for animal proteins deficiency. In this situation, a lot of researches showed the capacity of poultry farming to widely contribute to supply adequately this important need. In the aim to promote this important sector and the scientific excellence, West Africa Centre of Excellence in Poultry Science (WACEPS) is created in the University of Lomé, capital city of Togo with the help of World Bank. The training programs of WACEPS, focus on specialized international postgraduate courses, both Master and PhD degrees in poultry sciences, run the following options:

1. Poultry Production and Environmental Sciences;
2. Poultry Products Processing;
3. Poultry Diseases and Biosecurity of Poultry Industry;
4. Poultry Sciences Biotechnology;
5. Socioeconomics and Poultry Food Marketing.

In the aim to reinforce the training team, 3 post-doctoral positions are available at WACEPS.

Post-doc researchers are eligible for a contract of up to 1 year, under the standard University of Lomé salary and work status.

Eligibility criteria

Candidate must:

- Be a citizen of a country in west or central Africa;
- Hold a doctoral degree in animal biology, poultry science, agro economic, animal product processing;
- Have capacity to work in research team;
- Be free of any professional commitment;
- Speak and write English. An excellent knowledge in English should be a great asset.

Applications

Formal applications will include:

- One page resume of CV;
- A copy of doctorate diploma;
- A list of publications and print out.

Selected candidates must submit original biometric documents and transcripts and diplomas at CERSA secretariat in University of Lomé.
